Merwin Special Kids Day

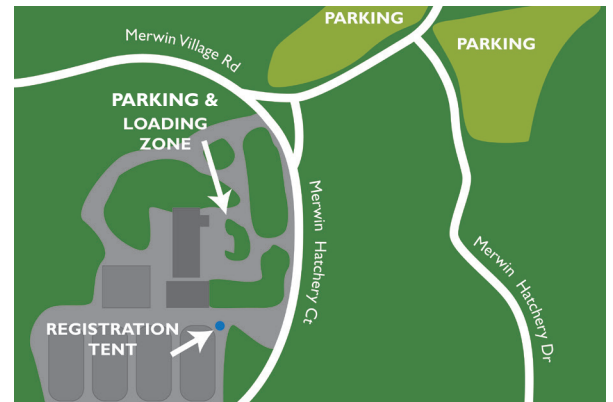

Directions: Merwin Fish Hatchery is located about 40 miles north of the Portland Metro area. Take I-5 north to the Woodland/Cougar exit. Go east on Highway 503 for 10 miles. Turn right at the Merwin Dam and PacifiCorp signs (Merwin Village Road).

Go ½ mile down the hill and follow the signs. A loading zone is available. Please park only in the designated parking areas.
